

Who are the Auxiliary Police?

The Sayreville Auxiliary Police are individual volunteers who assist the Police Department by performing traffic / crowd control at civic events (such as the fireworks, festivals, and parades), as well as uniformed patrols in the community. In the event of an emergency condition, the Auxiliary Police are also used to augment the Police Department.

All officers are provided with a rigorous initial training program at the Middlesex County Auxiliary Police Academy, as well as on-going professional training and equipment.

What are the qualifications to join?

- Must be 18+ years of age.
- US Citizen
- Sayreville Resident (or live within 5 miles of Sayreville if your town doesn't have an auxiliary)
- Clean & valid NJ Drivers License
- High school diploma / GED
- No criminal record
- Good moral character

Selection Process

- Submit an application (available online at: www.sayrevillepoliceaux.org)
- Oral board interview
- Fingerprints / photos will be taken
- Background investigation
- Training at the Auxiliary Police Academy.



Auxiliary Police Academy

All who are selected will be required to complete a 16 week paramilitary program at the Middlesex County Auxiliary Police Academy in Sayreville. Classes begin in March and are held every Tuesday and Thursday night as well as all day on select Saturday's. Classes include (but are not limited to): Drill & ceremony, domestic violence, hazmat, patrol functions, report writing, traffic control, civil government, court / courtroom standards, criminal law, motor vehicle law, fire safety, narcotics / CDS, juvenile crimes, gang awareness, preservation of evidence, power line safety, firearm / knife safety, bias crimes, CPR, use of force, arrest / search / seizure, and defensive tactics.
