Traffic Control – Manage traffic flow and ensure public safety at busy intersections and events.



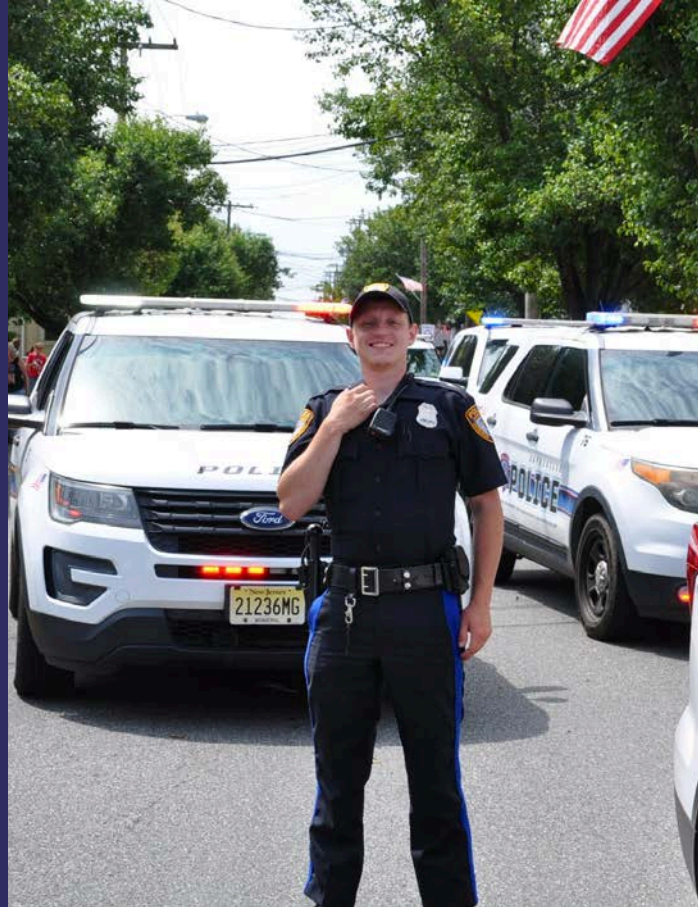
Disaster Response – Be part of the team responding to natural disasters and emergencies.

- Must be at least 18 years of age

- A resident of Sayreville or dwell within 5 miles of its borders (if your town lacks an auxiliary)
- Possess a clean and valid New Jersey driver's license
- Free from any criminal record
- Uphold good moral character, having no convictions for offenses involving moral turpitude

Academy Training:

Train with Purpose- Selected recruits will complete a 13-week, quasi-military style program at the Middlesex County Auxiliary Police Academy in Edison.

Starts in March-

- Tuesdays & Thursdays (some Wednesdays)
- Full-day select Saturdays

- Criminal & Motor Vehicle Law
